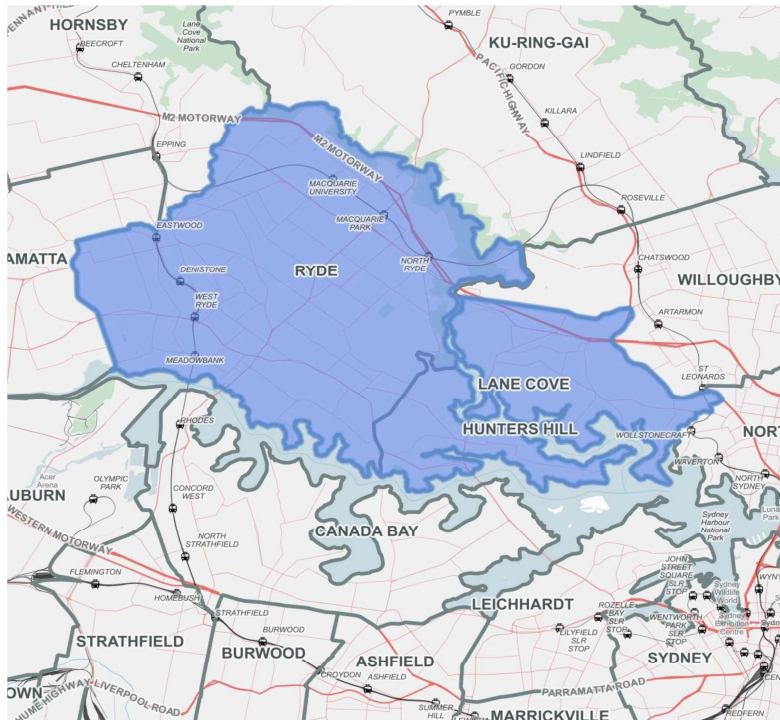


# Have Your Say!



## Proposed merger: Hunters Hill, Lane Cove and Ryde

Residents may, or may not be aware, that on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2016 the NSW State Government formally proposed an amalgamation of Hunter's Hill Council with Lane Cove Council and Ryde City Council.

It is important that the community has the opportunity to have a say about this proposal and you will only have a limited number of opportunities to do so, as there will be no public poll, or vote, on the proposal.
