


Bridge work on Victoria Road, Huntleys Point continuing from Sunday 14 April 2024

Community Notice

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumedegal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of ongoing maintenance of the state road bridges.

From **Sunday 14 April**, Transport for NSW will be carrying out night work for routine bridge maintenance on **Victoria Road**, **Huntleys Point**.

In January we notified the community about maintenance work to the underside of the bridge structure. We have completed five of the seven bridge spans and will now continue work to complete the remaining two spans.

We have also identified maintenance required for joint repairs on top of the bridge.

The two programs of work will be coordinated to minimise impacts for road users and the community.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- routine structural maintenance of bridge joints on top of the bridge
- maintenance and repairs to the underside of the bridge with minor vegetation removal.

This maintenance activity will improve safety for motorists and extend the life of the bridge.

When and where we'll be working

Our team will be onsite for up to six shifts above the bridge and 10 shifts below the bridge.

Work will take place between **Sunday 14 April** and **Friday 28 June** between **8pm and 5am.** Exact dates will depend on weather and other site conditions.

Work is not scheduled on Fridays, Saturdays or public holidays, but needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to workers and motorists.

What will this mean for you?

Temporary lane closures on Burns Bay Road are necessary to provide a safer work zone.

You may notice:

- · workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- noise from machinery and equipment.



Managing our impacts

We will manage our impacts by:

- reducing noise as much as possible
- turning off equipment when not in use
- positioning equipment away from homes and businesses
- completing noisier tasks by midnight.


Temporary traffic changes 8pm-5am

Changes you may notice include:

- temporary traffic changes during work hours to ensure the work zone is safe
- reduced speed limits and direction of traffic controllers and signs.

The bridge will remain open to traffic with one or more lanes operating at all times.
