Transport for NSW is carrying out this essential work as part of ongoing maintenance of State road bridges.

What work are we doing?

We are continuing bridge maintenance on Tarban Creek Bridge at Burns Bay Road, Huntleys Point and Hunters Hill. Work involves routine maintenance of the bridge structure to improve safety and to extend the life of the bridge.

A site compound will be accessed via Huntleys Point Road.

Work may be noisy at times, but we will reduce our noise as much as possible.


When and where we'll be working

We will be working on **Tarban Creek Bridge at Burns Bay Road, Huntleys Point and Hunters Hill**. See location map overleaf.

Work will be carried out between **8pm and 5am**, for a further **ten shifts** between **Sunday 30 June and Friday 9 August 2024**, weather permitting. We will not work on Saturdays or public holidays.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to provide guidance and direction around work zones.
