



HUNTER'S HILL COUNCIL CHARTER

1. Exercise community leadership.
2. Exercise Council functions with due regard for the cultural and linguistic diversity of Hunters Hill.
3. Properly manage, develop, protect, restore, enhance and conserve the environment of the area in a manner consistent with and promotes the principles of ecologically sustainable development (ESD).
4. Have regard for the long term and cumulative effects of Council's decisions.
5. Bear in mind that Council is the custodian and trustee of public assets and to effectively account for and manage those assets.
6. Facilitate the involvement of Councillors, members of the public, users of facilities and services, and Council staff in the development, improvement and coordination of Hunters Hill.
7. Raise funds for local purposes by the fair imposition of rates, charges and fees, by income earned from investments and, when appropriate, by borrowings and grants.
8. Ensure that, in the exercise of its regulatory function, Council acts consistently and without bias, particularly where an activity of the Council is effected.
9. Be a responsible employer
10. Keep the Hunters Hill community and the State Government (and through it, the wider community) informed about Council's activities.
11. Provide directly or on behalf of other spheres of government, after due consultation, adequate, equitable and appropriate services and facilities for the community, and ensure that those services and facilities are managed efficiently and effectively.
