**5.2 Reverse Vending Machine Installation**

A reverse vending machine will be installed in Henley Community Centre car park, following a decision of Hunter's Hill Council at the Council meeting held 23 November, 2020. This was advertised by newsletter, in printed communication and a dedicated news item. Key stakeholders were informed by email.

The machine accepts empty drink containers from users and provides them with a refund.

It will form part of the NSW Government's Container Deposit Scheme, known as Return and Earn.

It is expected that installation of the reverse vending machine kiosk will provide benefits in terms of minimising waste and reduction of waste costs.

Installation work will be undertaken by Council works team, Tomra and Stateline, and will commence from 11 March.
